The Xth Practical Course in Laparoscopic Urology

Dear Colleagues and friends

The Scandinavian Academy of Minimally Invasive Surgery (S*A*M*I*S) cordially invites you to Aarhus to attend the Xth annual practical course in Laparoscopic Urology, 02 – 04 September 2009.

The course will cover different aspects of laparoscopic urology and will mainly focus on practical issues such as technical skills, instrumentation, energy sources, and safe intra-corporeal suturing and knotting. The course is aimed at delegates who are already familiar with basic laparoscopic principles and will be an invaluable brush up for the adult and paediatric urologist.

On this tenth anniversary of the “Practical Course in Laparoscopic Urology” and as robotic surgery has become a mainstay in urological practice, robotic surgical mentoring has been extended to cover two full days for interested participants. New and emerging laparoscopic technologies which undoubtedly will crossover to everyday practice will also be discussed and evaluated with regard to possible applicability in especially paediatric urology.

We have again assembled a highly experienced faculty of Scandinavian and European laparoscopists, who will demonstrate, supervise, and lecture on topics that include

- Computer simulation
- Black box training
- Retroperitoneal access to the kidney and ureter
- Transperitoneal access to the kidney and ureter
- Intra-corporeal suturing techniques
- Dismembered pyeloplasty
- Heminephrectomy / Partial nephrectomy
- Nephrectomy
- Laparoscopic live donor nephrectomy
- Laparoscopic radical prostatectomy
- Robot assisted urology
- L.E.S.S = Laparoendoscopic single-site surgery
- S.I.L.S. = Single Incision Laparoscopic Surgery
- N.O.T.E.S. = Natural Orifice Transluminal Endoscopic Surgery
- Break out session for paediatric urologists

During the course, training procedures will be supervised and repeated a sufficient number of times to allow trainees to get an adequate understanding and sense for the demonstrated techniques. The number of participants, in the animal lab, is limited to 18, with 3 participants per pig.
